Patch cable lengths should be controlled with a surplus of no more than 500mm. Never use patch cables that are too short; connecting two patch cables with a no permit flange.

Never cut fiber optic cables. Why not? Fiber optic cables use infrared light, which is invisible to the naked eye. Looking directly into the end of a live cable can cause serious eye damage. Always ...

You can keep your network strong if you follow good steps for fiber patch cord installation and maintenance. Use mapped and labeled paths so work is faster and you avoid downtime.

Ensure you have patch cords matched to the installed cabling as optical fiber cords of different types should not be mixed. Choosing a cord of the correct length starts with determining the ...
