

# Electrical clearance of lighting distribution box

Sufficient access and working space shall be provided and maintained about all electric equipment to permit ready and safe operation and maintenance of such equipment.

There must be at least 78 inches (6' 6") of vertical clearance in front of the panel from the floor up to the ceiling or any obstruction. This is to allow someone to stand and work safely.

Working space: The front clearance, side clearance, and height clearance requirements for electrical equipment that provide a safe area for maintenance, inspections, and other work.

The lighting outlets shall be arranged so that persons changing lamps or making repairs on the lighting system will not be endangered by live parts or other equipment.

It can overlap the working space for other electrical equipment. The working space must be of sufficient width, depth, and height to permit equipment doors to open at least 90 degrees.
