

How big can a yellow tail fiber grow from tens of meters

Size: Yellowtail can grow quite large, with some species reaching over 1.5 meters (5 feet) in length and weighing more than 40 kilograms (90 pounds), though average sizes are usually smaller.

It has a metallic blue to greenish back, with silver sides and a distinct yellow tail fin. Adult individuals typically range from 2 to 4 feet in length and can weigh up to 40 pounds or more.

California yellowtail may grow up to 2.5 meters in length and may weigh up to 36.3 kilograms. The largest recorded individual was caught off Baja California and weighed 41.3 kilograms.

These fish can grow substantial, reaching lengths of up to 2 meters and weighing over 100 kilograms. However, individuals caught in resource-rich environments tend to bulk up more significantly than ...

Since they grow about three pounds a year, -today a three-and-a-half-foot, 20-pounder is a good one, and a 30-pounder is rare. Unmolested, yellowtail can reach five feet and 50 pounds or more.

Grows to 2.5 m in length and weighs up to 36.3 kg, with the largest weighing in at 41.3 kg (91.1 lbs). Found along the eastern Pacific from southern Washington to Mazatlán, Mexico (for California ...

The top is blue, and the bottom is silvery-white, and it has yellow fins. They are fast torpedo-shaped predatory fish and can grow up to 1.5m long and can weigh up to 52kg.

How long does it take to grow yellowtail to harvest size? Under optimal conditions, yellowtail reach a marketable size (around 3-5 kg) in approximately 12 to 18 months, making them efficient for self-use.

The Japanese Yellowtail can grow up to 1.5 meters in length and weigh as much as 40 kilograms. They are typically farmed in aquaculture settings due to their high demand, with the farming process ...

Yellowtail are found in a variety of habitats, from nearshore reefs and kelp forests to offshore pelagic waters in depths from the surface to 312 meters (1,023 feet).
