

# How to turn down the brightness of the amplifier

So, because of this unexpected change to the sound, I have been scouring the forums to read up on the brightness of the VM540ML and have read loads of great words of wisdom from this ...

The simplest way to reduce brightness is to lower the treble control on your amplifier. Start by turning it down gradually until you find a balance where the high frequencies are less harsh ...

In this article, I'll share my experiences with Fender amps and how I've tamed treble issues through guitar tweaks, speaker swaps, amp modifications, and pedals.

Cutting out or reducing the value of such bright caps can often help control an overly bright amp. After numerous changes to cut some ice-picking, most not giving me what I wanted I found the ...

Make sure you have a speaker hooked up to the amp. After about 5 minutes or so the caps should be discharged. At this point you can remove the bright cap and start experimenting. The smaller values ...

Turns the level meter display and meter lighting on or off. Displays the level of the signal input through channel 1. This can be turned off by pressing METER ON/OFF. This blinks when the protection ...

There's nothing incredibly wrong with me turning down my tone knob, except, I don't feel like I'm getting the most out of the amp this way. It tends to be a fine balance between getting too ...

Finally there is room treatment. Taming the mid/highs will help the bass bloom. If you can wait until you are in your 60's, the problem will solve itself, otherwise I would look into replacing the ...

Start with bass at 8, mid at 6, treble at 6 for a warm clean tone -- or flip it for brightness. Step-by-step guide to dialing in clean amp settings for any three-band EQ.
