

BusConnects is the National Transport Authority's programme to improve bus services across the country. Cities and towns are growing, they need a bus network that works for this growth. ...

From 8 February, the National Transport Authority (NTA), in partnership with Dublin Bus, will implement a series of amendments to Routes 80, 23 and 24.

Once operational it will improve the existing Transport for Ireland (TFI) network by providing enhanced bus services with high frequency spines and new local, orbital and radial routes.

BusConnects is an ongoing public transport infrastructure programme in Ireland, managed by the National Transport Authority (NTA), focused on the bus networks in several cities in the country.

Phase 6a of the BusConnects Network Redesign will launch on January 26th, 2025.
