In general, avoid using splitters you don't need. It seems like you have enough splitters for at least 12 coax outlets. If those aren't all in use, consider disconnecting the cables that aren't in use ...

So, yes, you could just put the splitter back in and potentially give yourself and the upstairs neighbor both access... But every splitter you put in generally degrades signal strength... so it may not work well.

It is possible you need a splitter to lower signal/raise return before your modem, however, the open port should be terminated. I would need to know your signal levels and what all ...

Splitters have multiple uses, including connecting multiple devices to a single cable outlet. If you have a free outlet go ahead and try adjusting or removing it if you prefer.

I have ensured that the MoCA adapter outlet is connected to a MoCa compliant amplified splitter (supplied by Xfinity) that has a built-in PoE filter. Modem is connected to the same splitter, ...
