

# Replacing the network cable with the fiber optic switch

Two fiber optic cables are required between each pair of fiber switch modules. Use a high-quality duplex fiber optic cable containing 62.5/125 or 50/125 Multi Mode fiber or 9/125 for Single Mode fiber.

A fiber optic network upgrade, simply put is to add a new network device to achieve media conversion, or to replace the existing networking device with a new one that enables fiber ...

A typical installation is optical fiber entering the premises and being connected to an ONT (Optical Network Terminal) device. The ONT converts the light pulses to ethernet.
