

The cover of the distribution box is covered with wall cloth

I had to rewire a bunch of stuff in a 1920s house once, which had cork boards on the wall in almost every room. I had to do some damage, and the homeowner asked what could be done to fix it.

The primary procedural detail involves ensuring the box opening is flush with the finished wall surface, which is essential for safely securing the device and preventing fire hazards.

The box on the right must be flush or have an extension ring installed to ensure that there are no exposed combustible materials behind the luminaire (not shown).

You must repair any non-combustible surfaces that are broken or incomplete so there's a maximum 1/4 inch gap at the edge of a cabinet or cutout box employing a flush-type cover [312.4].
