

What does fiberglass tail mean

Came out to my truck today and it had about a 6 ft. horse tail hanging out of the tailpipe. Looks to be fiberglass batting from somewhere along the exhaust...

What does it mean when, thick dark hair-like string is coming out of my tailpipe?

It is an early indicator that the muffler is failing. The interior metal frame work is ...

Sounds like fiberglass from the muffler getting blown out if anything. Most mufflers have a steel wool or fiberglass stuffing that they use to muffle the noise. Shouldn't really hurt a thing as there's lots of that ...

For a (real) round tail or nose I won't make any cuts at all. Unless you stretch the cloth out of shape while wetting it out it will wrap a round curve without wrinkling.

About three months ago, I put an aftermarket early turbo tail on my '74. The tail is all fiberglass, and quite light. It, in fact, feels lighter than

This is the best answer for this thread. It is your resonator that has a problem so you are seeing some fiberglass coming out of your tail pipe. We also experience that one last month.

I know what you mean about the swoop back but I don't know where you are going to get it from. I'll try to ask them one last time but I am afraid they may be tired of my emails as they ...

The "hair" that comes from a car's exhaust is actually the fiberglass used in mufflers, and having it come out of the exhaust could indicate a failing muffler.

Hair coming out of exhaust pipe is usually fiberglass insulation from inside the muffler or resonator. It can look like hair but is actually heat-resistant material breaking loose.

It is an early indicator that the muffler is failing. The interior metal frame work is rusting away allowing the packing to escape. Could this cause serious damage if I don't fix it now/soon? The problem will get ...

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
